**Central Elgin Water Systems Earn 100% Rating on
Ministry of Environment (MOE) Inspections**

The Municipality of Central Elgin's Drinking Water Systems earned a 100% rating on the most recent inspections carried out by the Ministry of Environment (MOE) of the Municipality's drinking water systems. Deputy Mayor Tom Marks stated, "The Municipality of Central Elgin is committed to providing safe drinking water and undertaking the work needed to maintain our drinking water systems and replace aging water infrastructure. The MOE inspection reports support these efforts and the work of our water system operators."

The Ministry of Environment inspection program for municipal residential drinking water systems determines compliance with requirements under the *Safe Drinking Water Act, 2002*, associated regulations and MOE licensing requirements. The 100% rating indicates that the Municipality of Central Elgin is fully compliant with the Ministry's drinking water regulatory framework.

The Municipality of Central Elgin owns and operates a water treatment system serving the community of Belmont. The Municipality also owns and operates water distribution systems serving Belmont and Port Stanley. The water distribution system servicing Lynhurst, Norman-Lyndale, and the Eastwood Subdivision is owned by Central Elgin and operated under agreement for Central Elgin by the City of St. Thomas.
