Toilet/Shower Head Replacement Program

This program is a low flow showerhead/toilet replacement program. The Township of Malahide will offer a rebate incentive to those residents of Malahide that replace old inefficient showerheads and toilets.

The program is available to residents that are on the Municipal water or sewage only. The program will start June 1, 2007 and will run through until September 1, 2007.

Rebate Amounts:



TOILETS:

- Any flush toilet purchased between \$0-\$100.00 will receive a \$45.00 rebate.
- Any flush toilet purchased between \$101.00-\$250.00 will receive a \$75.00 rebate.
- Any flush toilet purchased greater than \$250.00 will receive a \$100.00 rebate.

Only 1 toilet per household, 3 toilets for commercial.

SHOWERHEADS:

- A maximum of 50% of the price including taxes up to a maximum of \$35.00.

Example: \$85.00 showerhead will receive a maximum rebate of \$35.00.

Only 1 flow showerhead is permitted for this rebate



Why save Water?

- ◆ To reduce the need for upgrading water/sewage infrastructure
- ◆ It will save on your water bills and hot water bills
- ◆ It will increase the life of your septic bed
- ◆ It is good for the environment

How to tell if you need a low flow showerhead or toilet

SHOWERHEADS

If you have a low flow showerhead installed, it should read 2.5 gallons per minute or less directly on the showerhead, if not you should replace the showerhead with a more efficient one.

You can also set a pail (that holds at least 2.5 gallons) on the floor in the shower. Turn on the shower, fill the pail and count 60 seconds. If it fills to the 2.5 gallon mark in 60 seconds or less, you should be replacing your showerhead.

TOILETS

If your toilet is more than 10 years old there is a good chance that it is not a 6 litre toilet. If you know your toilet is flushing excessive amounts of water or you know it is a 13 litre of greater flush, you should replace your toilet with an efficient 6 litre flush

Did you know...

- ◆ 30% of ALL water used in your house is from your toilet
- ◆ An additional 20% is from showering or bathing
- ◆ If you use a low flow showerhead, a 15 minute shower can save you up to 140 litres of water per shower. That's 51,000 litres of water per person per year that can be saved.
- ◆ Using a low flow showerhead will reduce your hot water bills
