To See the HTML Source of a Website

In order to see the HTML code of a website that you are viewing you will need to select: (at the top of your browser window)

VIEW > SOURCE (in Internet Explorer) or VIEW > PAGE SOURCE (in Netscape)

Every Font Will Not Work Everywhere...

This is very important! A text font command will only work if the font you call for is loaded on the computer displaying the page. For this reason it is a good idea to stick to the most popular fonts installed with Windows so that everyone will be able to view the page as you do. (Arial, Verdana, Times New Roman, Courier)
